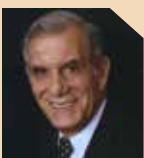

## Challenging Cases in Day-to-Day Obstetrics

### Description

Obstetric care can be very challenging. 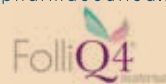

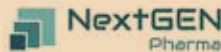
