Abstract



Endometriosis is one of the most common gynecologic disorders affecting 10% of women¹. Patients with endometriosis usually present with infertility and/or pelvic pain; however, many patients with endometriosis are asymptomatic.

In this presentation an updated evidence regarding the management of infertility and pain associated with endometriosis will be presented. The impact of endometriosis and endometriomas on the outcome of IVF will be explored. In addition, the role of surgery and IVF in the management of infertility associated with endometriosis will be reviewed.

The different hormonal suppressive therapies in the management of pain will be discussed. All of this will be done using different common clinical scenarios and evidence based medicine.
